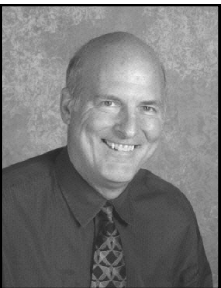

Join us to learn more about Moreland's Bonding capacity, the restrictions soon to be placed on these bonds and the lagging property assessments. Why are we unable to access the more than \$30 million in bonds, approved by the voters in 2010? There is a process whereby the Board could authorize a small tax increase, which would enable us to access these funds, while reducing taxpayers' long-term tax obligations.
